



Re-Entry Pet Import Protocol

Requirements

1. Pet must have an ISO compliant microchip such as AVID®, Home Again or ResQ.
2. One current rabies titer (titers are valid for twelve (12) months).
3. A health certificate from a St Kitts Veterinarian within ten (10) days of departure.
4. A health certificate from an accredited Veterinarian from the exporting country within three (3) days of arrival into the federation.
5. The St.Kitts Nevis Import Permit.

Procedures

- An Import Permit will be issued by the Veterinary Services, at least (no later than, may be earlier) 10 days prior to departure, once the Veterinary Services have received the following:
 1. Re-entry Application to Import Animal.
 2. Current titer information.
 3. Check payable to Account General for EC\$20.00.
 4. Re-entry Arrival Date and flight information.
- Please note the deadline for applications this semester is December 1 and the permit will be issued via email, but can also be **collected at the Veterinary Services office** behind the cemetery, if all the relevant paperwork is handed in.
- The airline requires a copy of a certification your pets rabies vaccines are current/up to date and a local health certificate within 10 days of travel.
- **Students will be required to produce the following at the airport in St. Kitts upon their return:**
 - ✓ Import Permit
 - ✓ A health certificate from an accredited Veterinarian from the exporting country within three (3) days of arrival into the federation.
 - ✓ The standard government fee of EC \$100 for the airport check will be collected on arrival.
